She will also have him review Section 607 regardig private roads and how this affects the Township Land Division Ordinance. Upon his return with his comments, the memeber will review, comment and schedule a public hearing so a final draft can be forwarded to the Township Board for their approval.

New Business
Supervisor Fountaine recevived a request for a possible variance from a Mr. John Meehan regarding the installation of steps in the side setback area of a non conforming lot for a new home. After some discussion it was determined that Mr. Meehan should reconfigure the new home on the lot, if possible, to meet all the required setbacks. If Mr. Meehan still requests a variance, he should be advised that the Township Board of Appeals can take this issue up, but the general feeling of this commission is that a variance would not be approved.
