#### **Permits**

- Mr Cobb applied for a Gunsmith Business. This permit was approved.
- Mr Godfrey applied for a T-Shirt Business. This permit was approved.
- 906 Vacation rentals applied for a Short Term Rental, located in R-2. This permit was tabled as more information is needed from the applicant.
- Yooper Rentals applied for a Short Term Rental, located in R-2. This permit was approved for use June 1 August 29, and must be renewed yearly.
- McBink LLC applied for a Short Term Rental, located in R-2. This permit was approved, but must be renewed yearly.
