

## What is the Home Heating Credit?

The Home Heating Credit (HHC) is distributed by the Michigan Treasury and is offered to help pay for winter heating bills.



In order to be eligible, Households must:

- Be at or below 110% of the Federal Poverty Level
- Meet exemption guidelines

A tree limb in contact with an electric line is extremely dangerous and life-threatening. Our mission is to keep the lights on while investing responsibly in safety, reliability and people. It prevents thousands of unnecessary power outages and saves tens of thousands of dollars in maintenance and line repair. To prevent trees from growing into powerline areas we trim trees every six years in residential areas and every five, six or eight years in



rural areas. Despite our hard work, trees and branches can still cause power outages, especially during storms.
